

Occupational Health and Safety Risk Management for Supervisors and Managers

This course aims to familiarise participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to apply the principles of Risk Management as an integral part of an effective OHS Management system under the OHS legislations. The course is broken into two separate days, about one week apart. Participants are given a work-based, practical task to complete, in between the two sessions. This enables participants to have real, hands-on experience in conducting a risk assessment in their own workplace.
