

# Safe Working at Heights

This Nationally Accredited Course is design to develop risk assessment skills and is ideal for those who lead small work teams, or are required to work with minimal supervision. This is a “hands on” course, and participants can expect to get practice using heights safety gear, practicing emergency response and carrying out risk assessment exercises within a team. It is designed and accredited at AQF Certificate III Level, so it is suitable for tradesmen and supervisors of small work teams.

This course is based on State Legislation, relevant Codes of Practice and Australian Standards.

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**DURATION:** 1 day

**PREREQUISITES:** All participants must bring photo ID to the course.

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**COURSE OUTLINE:**

- Legislative requirements, work procedures & heights safety hazards
- Risk Assessment and Control Measures
- Selection, fit and use of equipment
- Assessment of anchorage points
- Emergency planning and response
- Inspection and maintenance of heights equipment.

This is an assessable course and participants will need to demonstrate that are competence in the various skills covered in the training.

During the course, participants are assessed on practical work and participation in the classroom. There is also a written exam.

**WHO SHOULD ATTEND THE COURSE?**

Staff required to work at heights.

This course requires participants to complete reading tasks, written assessments and maths calculation. If staff are likely to experience difficulties in these areas, please advise the Training Coordinator.
