



Select/Modify Traffic Control Plans (Red Card)- Course Overview

This course provides training for personnel who are required to select and make minor modifications to existing Traffic Control Plans (TCP) to suit work locations. **NOTE: This course does not qualify participants to control traffic with a Stop/Slow bat, set up or work with traffic control plans or design a non standard TCP.**

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Explain the requirements of a Traffic Management Plan (TMP)
- Describe the Set out and Close down of a TCP
- Conduct a risk review for a TCP
- Make minor site specific modifications to approved TCPs
- Undertake routine daily and weekly inspections of the worksite

Participants must complete knowledge and skills assessment at the end of the course

- A minimum of 12 months demonstrated Industry Experience in roadwork and traffic management, **OR**
- Hold a **current** Select/Modify Traffic Control Plans (Red) Photo Card
