

Workcover Licensing – Skidsteer (LS)

Licensing is a legal requirement of operating these machines. The aim of these courses is to train participants in the use of loadshifting equipment in accordance with the OHS Act 2000/Regulation 2001 and WorkCover licensing requirements. It provides participants with a licence issued by WorkCover.

Participants will have ample time to practice their skills on modern machines.

The training venue is a working quarry, where participants will learn their skills in simulated, real work situations. Class numbers are limited to five to ensure each person in the course gets sufficient practical experience. Our trainers/assessors are professional and flexible, and treat participants with respect and dignity. Cool drinks, shelter and lunch are supplied.

To satisfy course requirements, participants are expected to complete written and practical assessment activities. The WorkCover Assessment Instrument will be posted to you upon registration for this course.

Before and during the training, it is vital that you commit extra time to study the course materials. This will ensure you have the best chance possible of completing the assessment exam to Workcover standards and being accredited to use the machine.

Participants who not pass the final assessment can return to be re-assessed. Re-assessment fees apply. Participants must be over 18yrs of age.

DURATION: 3 days (2 days training, 1 day assessment)

WHAT TO BRING:

- A WorkCover Assessment Instrument will be posted to you upon registration for this course. You must familiarise yourself with the documents prior to doing the course.
- For assessment each participant **MUST** have personal identification that adds up to 100 points – these requirements are on the next page. **Participants without ID will be sent home and will not be able to be assessed.**
- Hard hat, high visibility vest or clothing, steel capped boots

This course includes practical training, which is conducted outdoors. You may need wet weather gear to avoid getting wet in case of rain. In extremely wet conditions, the trainer/assessor may deem the practical unsafe. In this instance, practical training may have to be rescheduled.

**** Fees apply regardless of result ****

After the course \$65 must also be paid directly to WorkCover to get wallet card. This is done at the Post Office. Please also take a passport sized photograph to the Post Office with you.
