



Traffic Controller (Blue Card) Course Overview

This course provides training for personnel who are required to control traffic with a Stop/Slow bat.
NOTE: This course does not qualify a participant to set up or work with Traffic Control Plans (TCP's).

TARGET AUDIENCE

- Field Staff

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Understand the role of a Traffic Controller
- Apply the procedures of traffic controlling within a worksite
- Operate a 2-way radio correctly and effectively
- Promote the role of traffic controller in the Community

PRE-REQUISITES

- Adequate literacy

AND HOLD

- A **current** NSW WorkCover Construction Induction Certificate or equivalent*

**Occupational health and safety induction qualifications obtained in Victoria, Queensland and South Australia before September 1st 2009 are deemed to be equivalent to the NSW WorkCover Construction Induction Certificate. Construction Induction Certificates issued after this date in any state are acceptable.*

AND HOLD OR HAVE PREVIOUSLY HELD ONE OF THE TWO OPTIONS BELOW:

- A NSW P2 Drivers Licence or equivalent or higher **or**
- A NSW Traffic Controller Photo Card (expired within the last two years)

(Holders of overseas drivers licences, if not written in English must provide an official translation from the Community Relations Commission for a multicultural NSW or Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) The issue date must be a minimum of 12 months prior to the date of training)

PRE-REQUISITES Continued

- **NOTE:** Personnel performing traffic controller duties in “non-construction” area can attend this course without holding a NSW WorkCover Construction induction Card (CIC) or Equivalent. These participants will be issued with a Traffic Controller – Non Construction (Grey Card). Grey Card holders **must not** perform traffic controller duties at a roadwork/construction work site.

DURATION

1 day, 8:30am to 4:30pm

VALIDITY

The Traffic Controllers Photo Card is valid for three (3) years

DELIVERY

Classroom including practical exercise

Participants must complete knowledge and skills assessment at the end of the course
